Dates: Post Graduate course - MSc Charity Resource Management - part time

This course is for people working for charities or organisations with charitable status such as • local voluntary organisations • community organisations • partnership bodies • major fundraising charities • faith-based organisations.

There are two cohorts running, hence the two different calendars – exchange students can join either cohort.

We can accept students on any module that is running in either cohort. There are no specific application dates.

The modules listed under Charity Resource Management are sector specific but students can also take the core modules. (If any students want to take a module on one of the other routes we could consider it but cannot guarantee it.)

(OD&C – Ogranisational Change and Consultancy C&M – Coaching and Mentoring)

I note that our syllabi are in a very different format than everyone else's. This is the way we produce it at SHU. The only thing to note is that each module of the Masters course is worth 15 academic credits and the total Masters course is 180 credit points - 8 modules at 15 credits and a dissertation at 60 credit points. I am not sure how this compares with the credit weightings of the other institutions.

We do not have set application dates and are very flexible as it is a part time programme. All our courses are in English. Students can take as many or as few modules as they want.
