Dear students,
the following amendments have been made to the Syllabus:

April, 18:

- The seminar *Gesundheit und soziale Ungleichheit in Europa* (Heisig) takes place at WZB, room B004/005 (Reichpietschufer 50) as indicated in the KVV, not in room UG/5, as eVV suggested.
- Missing rooms and descriptions for all but one courses offered at the University of Potsdam have been added.
- The class *Interaction Rituals and Situations: Understanding Society at the Micro-Level* (Freudenberg) at the JFK institute has been replaced by a class titled *Religion Return Home*. We will add the instructor as soon as the name is known.
- The inconsistencies between the eVV and KVV in the time details of the seminar *Introduction to Data Analysis with STATA* (Ruß) and *Introduction to Data Analysis with SPSS* (Wanka) have been removed. The classes take place from May, 13 until June, 3 and April, 21 to June, 2, respectively.
- The seminar *Central East European Narratives* (Ignácz) is held in English.

April, 11 or earlier:

- The seminar *Stereotypen- und Vorurteilsforschung: Klassische Theorien und empirische Umsetzung* (Bankowski) has a new description.
- The registration mode to the seminar *Introduction to Data Analysis with STATA* (Ruß) has changed.
- The inconsistencies in the course venue of the seminar *Introduction to Data Analysis with SPSS* (Wanka) have been removed. The course takes place in PC-Pool 204.
