Dear students,
the following amendments have been made to the Syllabus:

October 18

- Due to a timetable conflict the seminar *Nationalism. (Re-) emergence and diffusion in Eastern Europe* (Varga) has been moved to Monday 8.30-10.00 s.t. (room 301) starting from the second week of classes.
- The *Colloquium Methoden* by Dieter Ohr has been added to the PDF version of KVV. It has been correctly listed in the electronic version but mistakenly omitted in the file.

October 16

- The seminar *Prekäre Beschäftigung – prekäre Lebenslagen?* (Reinhard Pollak/Stefan Stuth) has been moved Module 3 and from Thursday 10-12 to 12.30-14 s.t. due to a timetable conflict with the methods lecture. The new room is B001 (WZB). The class can still be attended as a seminar in module 8, although the preference will be given to students attending it as part of Module 3.

- The M3 seminar *Interpretation von vergleichenden Umfragestudien am Beispiel der Einstellungen zu Immigranten und Immigration* (Bankowski) has been cancelled.
- The M2 seminar *How the social embeddedness of immigrants matters - Contacts, networks, and ties in the integration process* (Schulz) has been cancelled.
- The seminar *Rückkehr zum Markt: Post- Kommunistische Gesellschaften im Vergleich* (Varga) has been added to module 2.
