## Guidelines

- The topic of your master thesis is binding. A concrete title of your thesis will be given in acceptance with your supervisor.
- The deadline for your Master thesis is 24 weeks after the official registration signed with this form.
- You are expected submit to the examination board three hard copies of your thesis.
- The length of your thesis should be 60 pages (app. 18.000 words); or a film (30-40 min) accompanied by a Master's thesis of about 8.000 words (25 pages); or a photography project (25 pictures, each with a caption) or other media project (Second Life, Web 2.0 projects etc.), also accompanied by a Master's thesis of about 10.000 words (30 pages).
- The attached *declaration in lieu of oath* has to be attached to one copy of your thesis (the one for the examination office)
- The thesis can be handed in the office of examination until 3pm of the date of deadline or sent by post until midnight (it must be post-marked before)
- You are advised to seek advice from your supervisors from the start of your official thesis working-time onwards.
