LANGUAGE COURSES		
Preparatory German language courses	A six-week intensive preparatory German language course (20 x 45 min of instruction per week) will be offered prior to the beginning of the summer respectively winter term. All language levels, including absolute beginners are offered. If students attend the pre-semester language course, a spot in an adequate level German language course during the semester will be guaranteed (not mandatory). The course fee will be approx. 780 \in . Language courses during the semester	German language courses, offered during the semester, are free of charge. If students wish to participate in a German language course, they have to take a placement test during the orientation days. Without this test, exchange students are not eligible to take language classes. VISA REQUIREMENTS		
Entry visa	Students who are citizens of EU or EEA countries, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, South Korea, Switzerland, UK or the USA do <u>not</u> need a visa in order to enter Germany. Upon arrival in Berlin, citizens from these countries (except EU) must only apply for a residence permit (see under "Arrival in Berlin"). Students who are <u>NOT</u> citizens of the countries listed above must apply for a student visa (<i>Visum zu</i> <i>Studienzwecken</i>) at the local German Embassy or a German General Consulate <u>before</u> they come to Germany. We therefore urge those students to apply for a study visa as soon as possible. It will take at least six weeks, sometimes months, to process the visa application. The necessary documents concerning the admission to our university will be sent via e-mail to the student as soon as possible. HEALTH INSURANCE		
Waiver	Exchange students must have comprehensive health insurance valid in Germany for enrollment as a full- time student at FU Berlin AND for obtaining a residence permit. Students who EITHER have the <i>European Health Insurance Card</i> or the <i>Global Health Insurance Card</i> (EU/EEA and UK students only) OR who can provide proof of an adequate comprehensive health insurance valid in Germany (unlimited in case of illness or rescue!) may request an insurance waiver. Please note that a waiver can only be obtained at a German state-regulated health insurance company, not at a university. Since many insurance policies purchased outside Germany require substantial co-payments, have caps or exclude many illnesses it has been increasingly difficult for exchange students to obtain a waiver. We therefore urge all BA-/MA-Students younger than 30 years to purchase a German student health insurance for about 120 € per month. A student health insurance offered by the German state-regulated health insurances is recognized by all doctors, clinics, hospitals etc. and students will not need to pay anything in advance. The German student health insurance policies are very comprehensive and are automatically accepted by the office granting residence permits. ARRIVAL IN BERLIN		
Enrollment	Upon receipt of all necessary documents (Health Insurance, Payment, Enrollment Form), students will be enrolled. After enrollment, students can immediately set up their FU-ZEDAT-Account. This Account is needed in order to register for courses and use the FU-Net, Wi-Fi and computers on campus.	

	We can only enroll students in the corresponding subject. A confirmation of supervision is necessary if students should be enrolled in subjects outside the Departmental Exchange Agreement.	
	Students will be admitted and enrolled as full-time students for the duration they have been nominated for by the Program Coordinator at Freie Universität Berlin.	
Social f ee s / public transportation	Exchange students are exempt from university fees, but they still need to pay the so-called social fees of approx. 270 Euro per semester. These are non-university related fees and pay for the student union as well as for a public transportation ticket for the whole area of Berlin for the entire semester. Students will be asked to pay the fees via PayPal before arrival in Berlin as part of the enrollment process.	
Residence permit	Once students have been enrolled at Freie Universität Berlin, they must apply for a residence permit (Aufenthaltserlaubnis) within three months (except students from EU or EEA countries). Students will be provided with detailed information and assistance upon admission via Distributed Campus.	
ORIENTATION		
Orientation days	Orientation takes place 5-10 days before the lecture period starts. It is necessary to participate in our orientation program. Students will be provided with essential information about studying at Freie Universität Berlin such as course selection and using the FU-Net, campus tours and how to use libraries and computers. Accommodation		
Private accommodation	Either students can organize their own private accommodation (such as student-shared apartments, so-called WG-Zimmer) or use the university's accommodation service offered by the ERG GmbH.	
University housing service ERG	The accommodation service offers a variety of accommodation options, including dorms, shared flats and fully furnished single apartments for <u>admitted</u> exchange students. All housing options are available from the beginning of September/October or March/April and cost about 450 - 850 Euro per month. Registration deadline	Since there has been a dramatic increase of student housing demand, students wishing to use our accommodation service must apply online as soon as possible and no later than <u>December 10</u> or <u>June 10</u> using the link above. Registrations will be on a first come, first served basis.

Modules	Bachelor's and master's programs are structured around modules, which usually consist of two content- related courses (e.g. a lecture and a seminar). While modules are offered on a regular basis (at least every 2nd semester), the content of the individual lecture or seminar might change from one semester to the other.	
Study and examinations regulations	Detailed module descriptions specifying contents, structure, contact hours and credits (Leistungspunkte, LP) can be found in the study and examination regulations (Studien- und Prüfungsordnung) at https://www.fu-berlin.de/en/studium/studienorganisation/pruefung/index.html (German only).	
Course catalogue	The courses offered during the current semester are listed in the course catalogue (Vorlesungsver- zeichnis, VV) which is available about one month prior to the beginning of the semester at <u>http://www.fu- berlin.de/vv/en/fb</u> . It is structured by departments, degrees and modules.	
Course registration	Students have to register for courses on our online portal Campus Management before the semester starts. Access and further information will be provided during the orientation period.	
Transcript of Records	Transcripts from Freie Universität Berlin are not issued automatically. Students who wish to obtain a Transcript of Records should contact their Program Coordinator at FU Berlin.
