



**What does the BSIO offer:**

The Berlin School of Integrative Oncology (BSIO) offers a structured 3-year doctoral program jointly educating basic scientists and physicians/medical students in the field of integrative oncology.

The BSIO is planning to award up to

**9 PhD student positions (Biomedical/transdisciplinary PhD track)  
3 MD scholarships (MD track).**

**Eligibility criteria – Biomedical PhD track (Dr. rer. nat):**

- M.Sc. in basic sciences or equivalent or
- B.Sc. in basic sciences (fast track) or
- medical students/graduates (who already obtained their MD or medical graduates who were among the best of their year)

**Eligibility criteria - MD track (Dr. med.):**

- enrolment in medical school or
- graduation from medical school

**Eligibility criteria – Transdisciplinary PhD track:**

- M.A. or equivalent in social sciences or humanities (potentially in addition to a M.Sc. (or equivalent) in basic sciences)

**Further eligibility criteria for all applicants:**

- a proof of English proficiency (as English is the graduate school's official language, e.g. TOEFL, IELTS or similar tests)
- 2 reference letters.
